## **Nomination Criteria**

To be considered for induction into The PhD Project Hall of Fame, an individual must have:

- Made significant contributions that have impacted The PhD Project's success. Commitment to The PhD Project is evidenced by involvement with our student and faculty members, participation on task forces and planning committees, recruitment activities, creating enhanced awareness of the PhD Project within an individual's own organization, or other involvements and actions to further the mission of The PhD Project.
- An excellent reputation within the academic, corporate or not for profit community and a source of inspiration and encouragement for others to follow.
- Served as an ambassador for The Project, communicating our mission within academe and/or corporate America.
- Demonstrated sustained involvement with The Project over a 10 year period.

## **Selection Process**

Nominations will be pre-screened by The PhD Project staff using the above stated criteria. Nominations that make it through the pre-screen will be forwarded to the current Hall of Fame members for review/rating to select up to 3 individuals to be inducted into The PhD Project Hall of Fame.
