FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is the program accredited?

Yes, by AdvancED/SACS/NCA/NWAC.

How long does it take?

The program has a 18-month, self-paced format. Most students transfer 8-10 credits (including GED tests) and can complete in 12-14 months.

How many hours?

The program is 750 course hours (120 hours in career courses).

What pace is expected?

Students should spend 10-12 hours per week on their coursework.

Do I have to show 8th grade completion?

Not if you are over 18 years of age.

Is the program in Spanish?

No, it is written in English at a 6th-8th grade reading level. It can be read aloud which may assist bilingual students.

Can I fail?

No, students must pass each assessment with a 70% or higher to move on. Tests can be retaken as many times as needed.

Will I get support?

Yes, you will be assigned a coach who stays with you the entire time you are in the program.
