About the Spark! Challenge

- Various Northwell Health site teams will virtually host 11th and 12th grade high school students and showcase their unique careers.
- This year Northwell Health will highlight in-demand careers that students can explore at each level of their educational journey. These careers may require certificates/training, associates, bachelors or advanced degrees (MD, PhD, masters degree).
- Students will cultivate essential skills such as research, communication, critical thinking, creativity, networking and collaboration.

Spark! Challenge The Details

- Any student who has an interest in healthcare careers (both clinical and non-clinical) is welcomed to participate. We recommend consulting with your guidance/ school counseling department to find students interested in these career paths. Additionally, we will provide a printable flyer for teachers to send home or advertise this opportunity within the school.
- On February 1, 2023, participating schools will have access to the virtual platform from approximately 9 am 1 pm.
- Each participating student will go through the program, highlighting 6-7 healthcare careers. Students will spend 20-40 minutes on each of the highlighted careers. Materials will be provided to follow along with any activities, when applicable. The day will be composed of both live and prerecorded content.
- After the virtual February 1, 2023 Spark! Challenge day, students form in groups of 3-30 over the next several weeks and will work together to create a poster, video, or both. In their video/poster they can spotlight one career they learned about. More details and guidelines to follow!
