ABOUT THE PROGRAM

This fellowship is a one-year, post-graduate, project-based program that selects fellows each year and is designed to provide the fellow with broad knowledge of healthcare operations and strategic planning. Under the guidance of their preceptor, fellows gain substantial experience and exposure to diverse divisions, departments and cross-functional teams throughout the organization.

Specifically, fellows will each lead a project that advances Advocate Health's commitment, is anchored in our strategic priorities and impacts the continuum of health and care. Ample opportunities will be available for fellows to lead and be active participants in other projects and initiatives as determined. In addition, fellows will be supported by a network of leaders and former fellows and encouraged to pursue their interests in operations, strategy, finance, quality, human resources, business development and/or other areas of health care.

PROGRAM HISTORY

Collectively, Advocate Health and its care delivery brands, Atrium Health, Atrium Wake Forest Baptist, Aurora Health Care and Advocate Health Care, have participated in offering administrative fellowships for over 40 years. The Advocate Health Administrative Fellowship is focused on health system operations. 

Atrium Health Wake Forest Baptist is a nationally recognized academic health system based in Winston-Salem, NC. The market is anchored by Atrium Health Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center, an academic medical center and Level-1 trauma center in Winston-Salem. The market is also home to Brenner Children's Hospital, a Level-1 pediatric trauma center, 4 community hospitals, and over 350 primary and specialty care locations. Winston-Salem is also home to Innovation Quarter, an innovation district anchored by the Wake Forest University School of Medicine.

Fellows at Atrium Health Wake Forest Baptist are provided with significant autonomy to shape their Fellowship journey around their short- and long-term career interests. Fellows can obtain project work impacting operations, strategy, finance, human resources, academic department administration, research, and more.

Fellows will also gain tremendous exposure to senior leadership teams through regular attendance at operational excellence meetings and leadership rounding. Fellows will receive regular mentorship from the program's executive sponsor and preceptor Dr. Cathleen Whealtey, DNP, RN, CENP, SVP Clinical Operations & President Atrium Health Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center.

The Advocate Health Midwest Fellowship Program is comprised of two market brands – Advocate Health Care and Aurora Health Care. Between the two brands, there are 29 hospitals, 600 sites of care, 11,000 physicians, and 22,000 nurses. The Greater Milwaukee market will soon be home to the Advocate National Center for Health Equity, the home base for advancing health equity across the enterprise.

The program is a one-year, project-based program designed to give fellows broad knowledge of corporate operations and strategic planning. Fellows gain substantial experience and exposure to diverse divisions, departments, and cross-functional teams throughout the organization. Each fellow will lead a large market project and have ample opportunities to lead or be active in other projects and initiatives in finance, operations, quality, human resources, strategy, business development, and/or other areas of interest.

Fellows also have a high-level of access to executive leadership throughout the fellowship by attending various leadership meetings and networking events. Each Fellow is supported by a mentor that is a former fellow, and a preceptor that is either a Site or Area President. The Midwest Administrative Fellowship program utilizes a cohort model where Fellows focus on their respective site/area, but attend certain meetings, social events, and development opportunities as a group.

Former Fellows have transitioned into a variety of roles in areas such as clinic operations, service line administration, business development, project management, and more.


