


## Refine your search with keywords!

Use the **KEYWORD** field to find jobs that perfectly match your skills and interests. Below are some examples on how to target specific roles and filter out irrelevant ones.

<u>Operator</u>	<u>Function</u>	<u>Example</u>	<u>Results</u>
<b>AND</b>	Provides results that contain both or all keywords	RN and ICU  Keywords <input type="text" value="RN and ICU"/>	Anything in the job description that has RN and ICU
<b>OR</b>	Provides results that contain either keyword	RN or Nurse  Keywords <input type="text" value="RN or Nurse"/>	Anything in the job description that has RN or Nurse
<b>Quotation marks “ ”</b>	Provides results with the exact phrase	“Registered Nurse”  Keywords <input type="text" value="“Registered Nurse”"/>	Anything in the job description that has the exact phrase “Registered Nurse” any anything after that phrase
<b>Parentheses ()</b>	Allows you to group together keywords and control the order in which the terms will be searched	(RN OR Nurse) and ICU  Keywords <input type="text" value="(RN OR Nurse) and ICU"/>	Anything in the job description that has the RN or Nurse with ICU
<b>NOT -</b>	NOT or the (-) will provide search results containing the first of your keywords but not the second. Make sure to put your keywords in the correct order when using NOT, as the search results provided will exclude the latter keyword.	“Registered Nurse” -cardiology  Keywords <input type="text" value="“Registered Nurse” -cardiology"/>	Anything in the job description that has the exact phrase “Registered Nurse” minus cardiology
