Why build a profile?

Building a profile on the Path to Pro Network is the best way to show potential employers you have what it takes to work in the skilled trades. Showcasing your work portfolio is the fastest way to stand out from other candidates.

What should be in your portfolio?

Photographs

Employers use photos to judge quality and craftsmanship. Do your best to take high resolution, well lit photos that show the details of your handywork.

Take photos before, during, and after to show show key stages of the process.

Generally sharing 3-5 photos for each project is best.

Descriptions

Clearly articulate the steps or stages during each project to give employers confidence in your ability to plan and execute your work.

For larger team projects, highlight your specific contibutions.

If you are entry level...

If you are new, it's ok to share smaller personal projects like upgrading a thermostat, repairing a toilet, or fence. Everybody has to start somewhere!

While it's best to show work that aligns with the trade you are persuing, it's ok if your projects dont exactly match. What is important is showing that you have the skills and dedication to complete the job.

Portfolio Dos & Do nots

- Do make sure that you are sharing work that relates directly to the Skilled Trades.
- Do keep in mind, no project is too small however, you should only show your best work.
- Do try to sequence project photos prior to uploading them to your portfolio.
- Do not include artwork, research, or photography projects.
- Do not post work that belongs to someone else unless you contributed and noted so in the description.
- Do not post work without providing a description.

Profile Picture

Your Work Examples
