***Please read the below information regarding the application process very carefully.

Program Eligibility Requirements:

- Entering or currently in their final year of an accredited BSN Nursing program (Graduation date between **December 2018** and **Spring 2019**) or enrolled within a Master's of Nursing Program through Cleveland Western Reserve.
- Cumulative GPA > 3.0 required, >3.2 or higher preferred
- Successful completion of an appropriate clinical rotation including but not limited to patient care activities such as ambulating, transferring, bathing and grooming.
- o Able to commit to the full 10-weeks of program.
- Able to commit to temporary full-time status (36-40hrs a week); shift rotations, off-shifts, weekends and holidays.
- Nurse externs are placed across the participating UH entities based on various factors including department and/or unit availability, applicant location preference, etc.

- o The application process consists of **two** (2) steps:

 - One completed comprehensive application submitted to electronically to lauren.revock@uhhospitals.org ATTN: 2018 RN Extern Application Please see page 4 for the comprehensive application checklist.
- Both Steps 1 and 2 MUST be completed to be considered for the program. There will be NO exceptions.
- Due to the high volume of applications received it is beneficial that the <u>completed</u>
 <u>application be submitted in its entirety</u>. Portions of the application received separately
 and / or individually (i.e. transcripts, letters of recommendations etc) *may* subject the
 application to delay or inability to process.
- Application deadline is Monday January 1st 2018.

 - This step, in addition to e-mailing in all information needed on the checklist, needs to be completed by January 1st, 2018 to be considered for the program.
- Expressions of interest via the UH Career Center made after the deadline will <u>not</u> be considered for the program.
- Students who submit a nursing extern application yet fail to complete the online expression of interest will not be considered for the program.

Important Requirements and Details:

- University Hospitals is dedicated to giving all those interested the opportunity to participate in the RN Extern Program
 - Please note- areas within the program are highly competitive with a limited number of extern opportunities.
- Nurse externs are placed across the participating UH entities based on various factors including department and/or unit availability, applicant location preference, etc.
- All newly hired employees are required to successfully complete pre-employment requirements set forth by University Hospitals, including background check, a medical examination and drug testing completed one (1) week prior to starting the program.
- Externs are required to complete all orientation and training as determined by the hospital.
- The Nurse Extern program is a temporary full-time work commitment (36-40 hrs /week) for 10 weeks. Nurse Externs <u>must</u> be available to work the full 10 week program from May 30, 2018 August 4, 2018.
- Schedule Requirements:
 - Externs are paired with a nurse preceptor and expected to follow their Preceptor's schedule, including rotation to off-shifts (evenings or nights), weekends and holidays.
 The first week is full time day shift to accommodate orientation.
 - Schedules are determined by the unit Nurse Manager, based on the scheduling practices
 of the unit and your preceptor's schedule.
 - Due to the length and educational nature of the program University Hospitals will <u>not</u> accommodate extended time off and/or planned vacations during the 10 week program.
