Scholarship Details

The Bridging the Gap Scholarship is a monetary scholarship of C\$7,500 towards tuition, a 4-month paid summer internship, and a TD Securities business mentor, intended to recognize outstanding Canadian undergraduate students (both academically and with respect to extra-curricular activities and/or community service) who identify as female, an Indigenous person, LGBTQ2+, a person with a disability, and/or a visible minority. A total of 4 Scholarships are available to be awarded for 2021.

Eligibility Criteria

Eligible applicants must identify with one or more of the following. Please check as many as applicable:

Female Indigenous person LGBTQ2+ Person with a disability Visible minority

Check both boxes below to confirm you are:

- a full time* student at an accredited Canadian university as defined by the Canadian Information Centre for International Credentials (“Approved School”), enrolled in a 4- or 5-year undergraduate program, and graduating in 2022.
- a Canadian citizen, permanent resident of Canada, or legally eligible to work in Canada.

* Applicants who identify as disabled and attend an Approved School on a part-time basis are still eligible to apply for a Scholarship provided they include written confirmation from their attending physician regarding the nature of their disability and how it does not permit them to attend an Approved School on a full-time basis.
