Scholarship Details

The Bridging the Gap Scholarship is a monetary scholarship of C\$10,000 towards tuition, a 4-month paid summer internship, and a TD Securities business mentor, intended to recognize outstanding Canadian undergraduate students (both academically and with respect to extra-curricular activities and/or community service) who identify as female, an Indigenous person, LGBTQ2+, a person with a disability, and/or a visible minority. A total of 12 Scholarships are available to be awarded for 2023.
