

Bridging the Gap Scholarship



TD Securities' Bridging the Gap Scholarship Program is intended to recognize outstanding Canadian undergraduate students (both academically and with respect to extra-curricular and/or community service), who identify as female, an Indigenous person, 2SLGBTQ+, Black, a person with a disability, and/or a visible minority. A total of 12 Scholarships are available to be awarded for 2024.

Successful applicants will receive



A 4-month paid internship position with TD Securities in Global Markets, Investment Banking or Infrastructure for the summer of 2024.



The benefit of a TD Securities business mentor available to them from the time their Application is approved and who will continue to be available up to and including the end of their 4-month paid summer internship position.



A monetary scholarship of C\$10,000 to be applied towards their tuition and school-related expenses for the 2023/2024 school year, upon completion of the 4-month paid summer internship position.

Candidate Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Identify as one or more of the following: female, an Indigenous person, 2SLGBTQ+, Black, a person with a disability, and/or a visible minority.
- Attend an accredited Canadian university as defined by the Canadian Information Centre for International Credentials ("Approved School") on a full-time basis¹.
- Be enrolled in a 4- or 5-year undergraduate program at an Approved School and graduating in 2025 or 2026.
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident of Canada, or legally eligible to work in Canada.

Application Requirements

Eligible applicants must submit a completed Scholarship application form by March 22nd, 2023, 5:00 pm ET that includes:

- A maximum 300-word essay explaining their interest in a career in capital markets;
- A maximum 300-word essay describing their extracurricular activities and/or community involvement and their commitment to the same;
- A copy of their most recent unofficial university transcripts; and
- A copy of their current resume.

Short-listed applicants will be required to attend a virtual interview with TD Securities.

Applicants who identify as a person with a disability and attend an Approved School on a part-time basis are still eligible to apply for a Scholarship provided they include written confirmation from their attending physician regarding the nature of their disability and how it does not permit them to attend an Approved School on a full-time basis.
